**Recycling of Household Wastes – Halkirk Transfer Site**

The Village does not pick up recycling. Residents must take Household Recycling to the bins at the Waste Transfer Site.

Tires, Electronics, Large appliances, Paints, Metals, are also accepted at the Transfer Site. Check with the Attendant as to where to place these items.

**Recycling bins for household wastes** are located at the Halkirk Waste Transfer Station. The bins are not segregated. All acceptable recycling materials will be placed in the bins. Do not put recyclables in black or green garbage bags. (It will be considered household garbage and disposed of accordingly).  
**No Styrofoam is accepted in the Recycling Bin.**

**PRODUCTS ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING:**

**PAPER:**

- Newspaper and inserts, magazines and catalogues
- White writing and computer paper
- Greeting cards, non-foil gift wrap
- Junk mail, paper bags, envelopes, paper egg cartons, paperback and hardcover books

Note: Shredded paper must be packed into clear bags.

**CARDBOARD:**

- Flattened corrugated cardboard boxes ( boxes when flattened must not be larger than 36 inches square)
- Flattened cereal and food boxes ( remove and discard liner)
- Flattened shoe boxes
- Milk Cartons ( rinse and flatten)
- Juice boxes

**METALS:** (No loose lids; lids must be trapped inside can or discarded; empty and rinse can)

- Clean tin cans (soup, vegetables, sauces, etc.)
- Aluminum containers (pie plates)
- Aluminum cans ( beverages)

**GLASS:** (Empty and clean; discard lids, labels can be left on)

- Jars (pickle, jam, etc.)
- Bottles (all beverages, ketchup, etc.)

**PLASTIC:** (Discard caps and lids, empty and rinse)

- Household cleaner bottles
- Pop and beverage bottles
- Milk jugs
- Detergent or fabric softener bottles
- Plastic bags (put together in one bag)
- Margarine and yogurt containers
- Plastic bottles (relish, salad dressing, mustard, etc.)

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

- Bundle or tie loose cardboard
- Put light items on the bottom of the bin and paper items in a bag so they don't blow out.
- Put all plastic grocery bags inside one bag, and tie.

#### **THE FOLLOWING WASTE IS NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING:**

- **Waxed cardboard**
- **Paper towels or tissues**
- **Ceramics, china, glass plates, light bulbs, or mirrors**
- **Tupperware or similar type containers**
- **Styrofoam packaging of any kind**
- **NO LIQUIDS OF ANY KINDS (ie MOTOR OILS, COOKING OILS, PAINT, etc)**
