Guidelines for Household Waste and Garbage Pickup.

Home Owner Storage Bins:

Garbage is to be stored in containers that are animal proof and weather proof. It is your responsibility to keep your garbage storage area clean. If you place bags at the curb, it is your responsibility to pick up stray garbage. The Garbage Truck will not pick up loose or scattered garbage.

General Information:

The Garbage Truck will only pickup household waste. Hazardous waste or Biological waste must not be placed in the household garbage. Large items, for example: furniture, carpet, appliances, trees, and construction material will not be picked up. It is up to you to take such items to the Waste Transfer Site. All Garbage is to be in sealed and tied Garbage Bags. Garbage bags are not to be over filled. If a bag is too heavy, it won't be picked up. The Garbage Truck does not have to pick up open bags or ripped bags. Loose Materials will not be picked up. Grass clippings or leaves need to be bagged. Bags must not be heavy.

Days and Time:

Household garbage will be picked up on Monday and Thursday each week. If Monday is a holiday, pickup will be Tuesday. Garbage pickup starts at 8:30 AM. The Truck will not come back to pickup garbage put out late.

Recycling:

The Waste Transfer Site accepts products for recycling. The Village does not pick up recycling. Residents must take Household Recycling to the bins at the Waste Transfer Site. Tires, Electronics, Large appliances, Paints, Metals, are accepted at the Transfer Site.
