

## **RV Rules & Regulations**

We appreciate all visitors to our community. To ensure that everyone is able to enjoy our community the following RV Rules & Regulations are in force. Please follow them at all times.

- All Recreation vehicles used for overnight stays in the Village of Halkirk must be registered
  with the Village office. You can register at www.halkirk.ca. Email transfers can be sent to
  cao@villageofhalkirk.ca.
- Serviced campsites in the Berry Street Campground are \$35.00 per night. Camp sites at the Recreation Grounds or on public streets are \$15.00 per night.
- Respect quiet hours: Designated quiet hours are from 10 pm to 8 am. Keep noise levels down during these times to allow others to sleep and relax.
- Keep your campsite clean: Leave your campsite as clean as you found it, or even cleaner.
   Dispose of trash properly and keep food stored in sealed containers to avoid attracting wildlife.
- Be mindful of generator use: If you're using a generator, be considerate of your neighbours and only run it during reasonable hours.
- Respect others' space: Be respectful of others' personal space and avoid walking through their campsites.
- Control your pets: If you're bringing pets, keep them on a leash and clean up after them. Be respectful of others who may not be comfortable around animals. Do not leave your pets unattended.
- One camping unit per site.
- Fireworks are not permitted.
- The Village of Halkirk is not responsible for injury or damage to property while you are visiting our community.
